

## PROGRAM 2b

### FETHIYE – MARMARIS

**Type of Boat:** Traditional Wooden Gullet (M/S)

**Duration:** 3 Nights – 4 Days

**Departure Days:** Friday – Wednesday

**Embarkation:** Fethiye Harbour

**Embarkation Time:** Before 10:30 a.m. on Fridays / Wednesdays

**Disembarkation:** Marmaris Harbour

**Disembarkation Time:** Before 10:30 a.m. on Saturdays / Mondays

**Optional Excursion:** Turkish Hamam

**Departure dates:**

Friday departures : Every Friday between May 10<sup>th</sup> and October 18<sup>th</sup> inclusive.

Wednesday departures : Every Wednesday between May 08<sup>th</sup> and October 23<sup>th</sup> inclusive.



**Day 1:GOCEK GULF (YASSICA ISLANDS – TERSANE ISLAND – BEDRI RAHMI BAY)**

*The guests must embark the boat before 10:30 a.m. from Fethiye Harbour.*

After breakfast, we will cruise to world-famous Gocek Gulf. While moving through uniquely beautiful islands, we finally anchor at Yassica Islands. Lunch will be taken in this beautiful chain of little islands. We will anchor at Tersane Island for tea-time and swimming break. This naturally protected harbour was used as the shipyard in Byzantine and Ottoman times. For dinner and overnight stay we will cruise and anchor in Bedri Rahmi Bay. Bedri Rahmi is a famous Turkish artist who made one of the first 'Blue Cruises' in Turkey. Following his visit the bay was named after him.



**Day 2: GOCEK GULF (MANASTIR - AGA LIMANI)**

After the breakfast we will cruise to Manastir (Monastery) Bay. Lunch and a swimming break, will take place in here. This place is also known as Cleopatra Bay or Sunken Bath Bay due to the beautiful underwater ruins of an old bath. Afterwards we will cruise to Aga Limani for dinner and anchor here for overnight stay.

**Day 3: KUMLUBUKU - CENNET ISLAND - MARMARIS**

Today, we will cruise to Kumlubuk Bay early in the morning. Breakfast will be served in Kumlubuk Bay. We will anchor at Cennet Island for our last swimming break and lunch. We will enter Marmaris Harbour by 16:00 p.m. and overnight stay will be in Marmaris. Guests wishing to see more of Marmaris are recommended to go to the city centre and experience the lively night life.

**Day 4: MARMARIS**

The guests will leave the boat with precious memories by 10:30 after breakfast.

### DEPOSIT & PAYMENT

- To secure your reservation, a deposit of **25 %** of the charter fee per person is required within seven **(7) days** of booking.
- Final payment is required **60 days** prior to departure.
- All payments may be made by Visa, Master Card, or American Express or by money transfer.
- All reservations are subject to cancellation if payments are not received by the due date.

### CANCELLATION & REFUNDS

- For full refund of charter fee, notice of cancellation must be in writing and received by our agency no later than **60 days** prior to sailing.

### **If a cancellation occurs, the following charges will apply:**

- 60-31 days prior to departure: **25%** of cruise fare
- 30-16 days prior to departure: **50%** of cruise fare
- 15 days or less prior to departure: **No refund**

Refunds will normally be made to the booking party. Our Agency can only be responsible for refunding amounts actually received. No refunds will be made to passengers who do not board the boat or passengers who cancel after the start of the cruise. We recommend the purchase of travel insurance.
